Searching for Classes

A new way to search for classes! You can now search for classes using word-based searches. Initial results will be returned based on the keyword or keywords entered. Those results can then be filtered further using specific criteria.

Step	Action
1.	Click the Manage Classes tile within the MyNIU Student system.
2.	Choose Class Search and Enroll from the left menu.
3.	 Enter keyword in the Search for Classes box. Keyword Examples: French English 19 Program Econ 261 The search will return any classes with the specified word or partial word. A search for "program" yields classes with the words program(s), programming. Multiple words can be entered but fewer results will be returned.
4.	Results will display all classes that meet the criteria. Ver tack Results Process of Result

5.	Additional filters appear on the left side allow you to narrow the returned results. Choose the filter(s) by clicking the blue text.
	Example: Perform a search for days of the week. You need a Monday/Wednesday/Friday class that starts between 8 am and 12 pm.
